## FROM MINISTERIAL SERVICES

### International News

Members' Safety in Geneva Mr. Dibar Apartian, Regional Director for the French-speaking areas of God's Work, received a telex from the office manager in Geneva, Mr. Bernard Andrist, relating a recent incident that is a sign of our times:

"On the Sabbath, 10th of October, just after I gave a sermon on: 'Put Your Trust in God,' Mrs. Dind, the manager of our meeting hall, came to see me. She was upset and told me that she just received a phone call from somebody asking if the meetings of 'Le Monde A Venir' (World Tomorrow) are at 10 a.m. Then the voice on the phone said: 'Tell them that they too will receive their parcel.' We are certainly associated with the Jews--in Switzerland Fascism is lifting its head too."

Please pray for God's protection for our membership and the halls we use in Europe as conditions deteriorate.

Philippines The Philippines office reports that last August 24 an ad was placed in Panorama Magazine, the Sunday magazine of the Bulletin Today newspaper. The booklet, "Does God Exist?" was offered plus a six-month subscription to The PLAIN TRUTH. The ad seems to be doing well because after one week 1262 responses came in. Cost per response is presently assessed at ₱4.30 (US \$0.59). It is hoped that this figure will go down as more responses come in.

With special thanks to continued Canadian and U.S. support, the Manila office says the superb glossy PT magazine really attracts. Newsstand displays of The PLAIN TRUTH in full color and in high quality glossy paper attracted almost 1,500 new subscribers. In the past, combined newsstand responses averaged only 500 per month.

A total of 2904 new requests for PT subscriptions came in during August --73% more than the total of new requests during the previous month.

Mr. Adair's PT lecture on the "Middle East In Prophecy" attracted 69 new people on August 31 in Muslim Samboanga City, Mindanao, some 850 kilometers southwest of Manila. The lecture was Mr. Adair's sixth for this year. Thirty new people attended the follow-up in the afternoon of the same day.

Cumulative income as of August 31, 1980 registered an increase of 27% over the same period last year.

German-Speaking Area The Feast of Tabernacles and the Last Great Day were the highlights of the fall feast season. One hundred and sixty feast goers, sixty of which came from overseas, kept an inspiring as

well as physically blessed Feast in Karlsbad, Czechoslovakia. Satan's attempt to ruin the Feast by initially thwarting the attendance of our East German and Polish brethren was unsuccessful.

High spirits and gorgeous weather marked attendance at the other German-language feast site in Bonndorf, in West Germany's Black Forest. An exhilarating feeling of unity and comradeship was present, inspiring the members attending as well as leaving a good impression on the community. (Many Bonndorfers said our congregation was "the neatest and best organized" of all the various groups having used the Bonndorf Convention Center.) A total of 600 members attended at Bonndorf; of these, 50 transferred from other areas. The offerings on the first and second holy days showed increases of 18.9% and 76.1% respectively; attendance for the feast site was up 6.8% over 1979.

As a result of a letter to 1600 donors offering the German GOOD NEWS magazine, we have added 300 new subscribers to the GN list.

Also a letter from the German Regional Director, Mr. Frank Schnee, to more than 5800 co-workers and donors, offering the German edition of Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong's book THE INCREDIBLE HUMAN POTENTIAL, brought 2241 requests in September. Requests are still coming in.

The mail income for the month of September was up +28.3% over September 1979. The year-to-date mail income total is up +19.6% over 1979.

# Mr. Attorney General of California:

## Congratulations! You did mean what you were saying!

Appeared in the Los Angeles Times October 23, 1980

**WE** TOOK YOU at your word. And you kept it. While you were lobbying against the Petris bill in the California legislature, you were saying—and your deputies were saying—that if this bill passed you probably would find it necessary to drop your lawsuit against the Worldwide Church of God.

This statement was made to members of the California senate, to members of the assembly, to the governor, to newspapers and to news people of TV stations throughout the state.

In this nationally famous lawsuit you had been claiming, based on your interpretation of a formerly existing California law, that you, acting on behalf of the state, should own, supervise and monitor ALL CALIFORNIA CHURCHES, their properties and church activities! This, in violation of the United States

Constitution and the First Amendment!

The Petris bill rescinded the former law on which you based your unconstitutional lawsuit and claim to ownership and control of all California churches. You lobbied vigorously against the Petris bill, which rescinded the law on which your contention and lawsuit were based.

The Petris bill was passed in the senate by a vote of 52 to 1. In the assembly 50 to 12. It was signed into law Sept. 30 by Gov. Edmund G. Brown Jr. Apparently they took you at your word that this would cause you to decide to drop your unconstitutional lawsuit against this Church.

Your office had selected the Worldwide Church of God as its test case. We were to be the

first domino, and if we fell, all other churches would follow.

Although their doctrines and practices differ somewhat from ours—even as they do from one another—the major and minor church denominations came to our legal aid in this state vs. church lawsuit, as also did the American Civil Liberties Union.

We take no part in partisan politics.

We are grateful to the major and minor churches who came to our legal aid. We thank the lawmaking body of California for taking you at your word and giving you this MANDATE!

We too thank the living GOD for giving you, Mr. Attorney General, the courage and moral strength to KEEP YOUR WORD. You are, indeed, a man of your word!
